

STUDENT SOCIAL SERVICE – MANDATORY SSS-O
11th - 12th GRADE STUDENTS

According to Colombian law, all 12th graders must complete a total of 80 hours of social service to receive a Colombian high school diploma. These hours can start being completed as soon as the student finishes 10th grade. Traditionally, 11th graders participate in a service trip in May where they often earn between 20 and 30 hours. Each quarter students should complete at least 10 hours. The school has contacts with the following entities, but the student may look for or propose other options.
