A. EDUCATIONAL FEES

1. Registration

- a. Before starting the school year, a registration fee equal to 10% of the annual total is due.
- b. The registration fee is nonrefundable, and necessary to confirm intent to attend ECA.
- c. If the student enters after the first quarter, the registration fee will be 20% of the registration fee plus 8% more for each month the student will attend.

2. Tuition

- a. August tuition is due by August 2, 2019 and has a discount.
- b. September through May tuition payments are due the 30th of the month.
- c. To receive the early payment discount, the complete payment must be made no later than the 10th of each month. The discount does not apply after this date.
- d. Payments made after the 30th of each month will start to incur interest at **half** the current legal rate on the 60th day it is past due, as stipulated in the contract.
- e. For elementary students enrolling after the first 15 class days each semester, the tuition payment will normally be calculated starting from the enrollment date. For secondary students, tuition payment is complete for the entire academic period (quarter) in session. If current transfer grades are submitted, tuition can be prorated for the portion of the quarter in which the student is enrolled.

B. PERIODIC CHARGES

1. <u>Transportation</u>: School van use is optional and usually door-to-door or school-toportería to most locations. A minimum commitment of 1 semester (5 months) is required.

Cash payments at the cashier window are available for paying **optional** services. Payments in **cash** for basic educational services (registration and tuition) are not received at the cashier window.

H. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Students are expected to meet academic and behavioral norms to continue to be eligible to receive discounts or scholarships. This includes absence and tardy standards.

I. LATE FEES / PENALTIES

- 1. Any family paying after the 30th of any month will be charged half the legal interest rate, as stated in the contract.
- 2. Any family not paying transportation within the first 10 days of the month will have their children suspended from school transportation.
- Any family who registers and/or pays the registration fee after August 2 will pay an additional \$100.000/family. This does not apply to families who bring transfer grades during the school year.
- 4. Any continuing family who 1) turns in incomplete financial documents for their scholarship application, or 2) turns in required legal documents for the enrollment process after the deadline, or 3) finishes the online enrollment after the deadline, will pay a fine up to \$180.000 (\$60.000/each step) for extra costs generated by the delay.
- 5. Parents are to submit written notice at least 30 days prior to withdrawal during the school year. Emergencies will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Parents will be charged a minimum of 1 month tuition (and transportation and food service if applicable) after notification. Tuition will usually be paid for the period of absence when grades will be received for the corresponding marking period(s).
- 6. Families cannot start the school year until:
 - a. Outstanding bills from the previous year are paid
 - b. Registration is paid
 - c. Registration is complete, which includes submitting all documents and signing the contract(s).

J. OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS

For any family who still has outstanding accounts on the last day of school, a *pagaré* or post-dated check and an official, signed agreement is required prior to granting official academic records or to participating in graduation ceremonies. Any family who has outstanding accounts on the last day of school, or who has consistently failed to pay on time for more than 50% of the school year and thus violated the contract, will not be guaranteed a spot for the upcoming school year. If desiring to continue, a family in this situation must arrange a meeting with the administration and turn in a new financial study to be considered for retaining their spot. A personalized payment commitment will be required.
