



## Middle School Summer Reading – 6th-8th

### Option # 1: Slides Presentation: Book Report

#### Assignment Overview

You will create a slides presentation about one of the books that you read to present in the first week of class. The slides will be in a book report format. All requirements must be followed. You are expected to use creativity and detail in this presentation.

#### Requirements:

- **Title slide** (1 slide): Includes the title of the book and your name
- **About the author** (1 slide): Includes the author's name, a picture of them, and 3-4 sentences about them.
- **The plot** (3-6 slides): Introduction, conflict, rising action, climax, falling action, resolution
- **Character** (1-2 slides): Introduce the main character of the story and at least 3 things about them. (second character optional)
- **Opinion** (1 slide) : Write your opinion of the book in 3-6 sentences.
- **Biblical Integration** (1 slide): Make a genuine connection between this book and God, the Bible, or your walk with the Lord.
- Creativity: at least 5 pictures in slides, nicely decorated slides with a theme, neat and organized.

## Option # 2: Video Project

### Assignment Overview

You will create a video to go over the book that you read to be shown in the first week of class. This video will be done either as a book report or telling a story. All requirements must be followed. You are expected to use creativity and detail in this presentation.

### Requirements

**Title:** a title image is included with the title of the book and your name.

**About the author:** the author is mentioned with 3 details about them.

**The plot:** Introduction, conflict, rising action, climax, falling action, resolution.

**Characters:** The characters represented in the book are clearly shown and identifiable.

**Opinion:** At the end of the video either include your opinion by saying it or with an image that contains your written opinion.

**Biblical Integration:** Make a genuine connection between this book and God, the Bible, or your walk with the Lord and explain it at the end of the video either by saying it or with an image that contains a written explanation.
